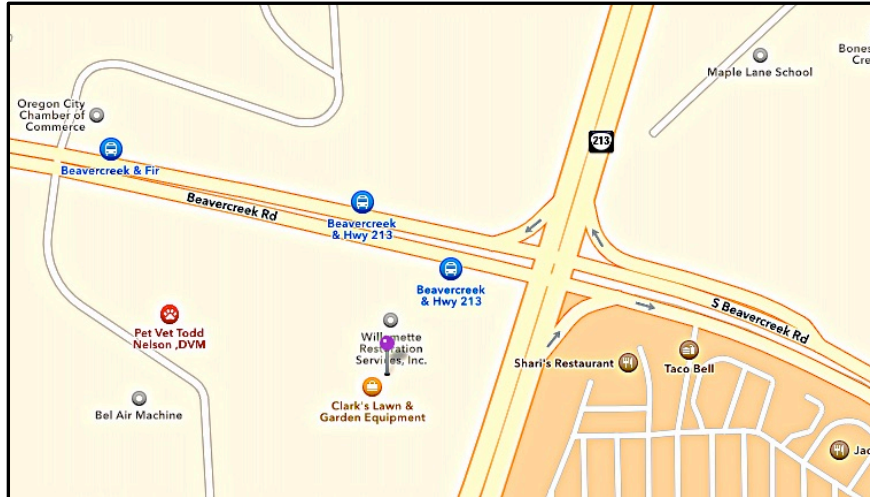


WHAT'S NEW:

Moving has begun! **We plan to be moved in by the August Food Bank – Saturday August 18th!** During the remainder of August we will be moving “stuff” to the new location and getting rid of stuff. YOUR IMPACT:

FIDO Pet Food Bank through the PureBred Dog Community (Nancy’s Friends) provided over 3,500 lbs. of Pet Food and Supplies to the Evacuation Shelters in the Redding area for Victims of the Carr Fire through relays of several PureBred Dog people.

FIDO got a call from Fort Kennedy that a Veteran was in need due to being evicted. They asked for kennels to temporarily house the Veteran’s 5 cats. We provided the crates that day.

FIDO received a call from a Veteran who was out of food for his dog and had no resources or means to come to the warehouse. We delivered food to his location!

FIDO is currently providing food for the pet companions of 16 Veterans at the Salvation Army Veterans and Family Center in Beaverton. This is a two-fold increase. We are feeding over 20 pet companions.
